

# Sport Shoe Policy 2015

As previously notified the new Sport Shoe Policy comes into effect from the beginning of Term 2. Please be aware that this will be strictly enforced with no exceptions. If students are not following this rule they will receive a uniform detention consistent with any breach of uniform.

The new policy is that sports shoes must have a sports sole (not a flat sole) and be either **predominantly white** or **predominantly black** in colour. They must have laces that are either black or white. If you are purchasing shoes from now could you please adhere to this policy. Please note shoes cannot be canvas shoes (such as Vans, Volleys or Converse), skate shoes, gym boots or other casual footwear. The purpose of the shoe is to provide support during sporting activity.

As a guide for parents and students please see the pictures below. If you have any specific queries please ask.

Parents are reminded that if you purchase a black leather sports shoe, it will be suitable for use with the normal and sports uniform as well as TAS classes. TAS classes are compulsory in Years 7 & 8 and elective subjects in Years 9 & 10. It is mandatory in TAS classes that students wear shoes with solid leather covering of the toe.

## Acceptable Shoes

Black Leather (suitable for use as part of normal and sports uniform and for TAS classes)



White Leather (suitable for use as part of sports uniform and for TAS classes)



Predominantly White Shoes (suitable for use as part of the sports uniform but NOT for TAS classes)



Predominantly Black Shoes (suitable for use as part of the sports uniform but NOT for TAS classes)



## Unacceptable shoes

Gym boots, slip on shoes, Vans, Converse of any colour.
