Dear Year 12 Parent/Guardian,

The following dates are for your information and for forward planning for 2020:

- **Thursday, 25th June & Friday, 26th June** – College Photos – Individual, Pastoral Care Group and Year Group Photo. This photo will be used in the graduation ceremony/yearbook. If students are not at school, they will not be in the photo. Students are required to adhere to College uniform policy for College photos.
- **HSC Trial Examinations** – Monday, 3rd August – Monday, 17th August
- **Practical Examinations and Submitted Works Term 3 August/September (dates tbc)–**
 - Society and Culture Personal Interest Projects
 - Submission of Visual Arts – Body of Work
 - Language Examinations
 - Practical Examinations and submitted works – Drama, Music, Dance
 - Projects submitted and marked for Design & Technology, Textiles & Design, Industrial Technology (Multimedia/Timber)
 - English Extension 2 – Major works
- **Wednesday, 23rd September** - Final charity fundraising day, compulsory dance rehearsal for the Graduation Celebration and rehearsal for the Graduation Mass and Awards Ceremony followed by a celebratory barbecue.
- **Thursday, 24th September** - Graduation Mass and Awards Ceremony at Xavier Catholic College. This is the last official school day for Year 12 students and all parents are encouraged to attend.
- **Thursday, 15th October - Friday, 6th November** - HSC written examinations.
- **Friday, 13th November** - Xavier Catholic College Graduation Celebration (Formal). Students will start arriving from approx. 4.30pm.
- **Tuesday, 15th December** – HSC Results released
- **Wednesday, 16th December** – ATAR Breakfast
- If illness or misadventure prevents a student from completing a scheduled in school Assessment Task an *Absence from Assessment* form needs to be completed. - If illness or misadventure prevents a student from attending a scheduled HSC practical examination or affects their performance it is their right to lodge an illness/misadventure appeal. The Illness/Misadventure form will be available from Mrs Falvey, Assistant Principal – Teaching & Learning and Mr Robinson, Leader of Curriculum.
- If illness or misadventure prevents a student from attending a HSC examination or affects their performance in the HSC examination, it is their right and responsibility to lodge an Illness/Misadventure Appeal. Appeal forms and the *Illness/Misadventure Information Guide for Students* are available from the Presiding Officer or the Principal. These documents provide further details of appeal procedures. It is important that instructions provided are followed.
- At the completion of their HSC Examinations, Year 12 students are required to return any school resources loaned to them and ensure fees are paid prior to being officially signed out of school. Once this has been completed students will be able to collect their Graduation Dinner/Dance tickets and any pre-ordered photos.
