- **Year 11 students** will be returning to receive feedback on end-of-preliminary exams and important information and preparation for the commencement of the HSC course next term.
- **Year 7-10 students** will finalise remote learning activities and commence new work for the remainder of the year.
- **ALL** students are required to supply and wear their own **mask** while indoors, including on the buses.
- We return in **SUMMER uniform** for all students; please ensure students have a hat for outside play.
- Please bring a **drink bottle** to reduce possible contamination of water bubblers.
- **Ordering of food** for canteen purchases please use your Flexischools App. There will be limited 'walk-up' purchasing.
- **Friday is a normal school day**. The calendar lists this as a **Staff Development Day - No Students**. We have **CANCELLED** this professional learning opportunity for staff to keep students in class as much as possible.
- **Parents are not permitted on-site** (I apologise for this, it is a CSO and CSNSW rule). Please conduct as much of your business online or on the phone please. Again, my apologies for this.
